An **organism** is any living system.

Ex. animals, plants, fungus, etc.



A **population** is a group of organisms of the same species that live in a particular area. All of the pike in a lake would form a population.

A collection of populations of all the species in a particular habitat is referred to as a **community**. A community in a lake would include populations of pike, perch, tadpoles, mosquito larvae, algae, etc.

An **ecosystem** refers to the relationships among many species living in an environment and the relationships among those organisms and the non-living components of the environment.
