Roles in the Ecosystem

Ecological niche – an organisms place in the food web, its habitat, breeding area and the time of day that it is most active.

It includes everything an organism does to survive and reproduce.

Roles in the Ecosystem

• Animals have developed different niches within the same ecosystem with other animals. For example the hawk and the owl and different species of warblers. (Figure 1 and 2 pages 40-41





Competition for Niches

- Introduction of a new species, called an exotic species can cause a disturbance in an ecosystem.
- Humans introduce exotic species. Ex. African Honey Bees, Zebra mussel
