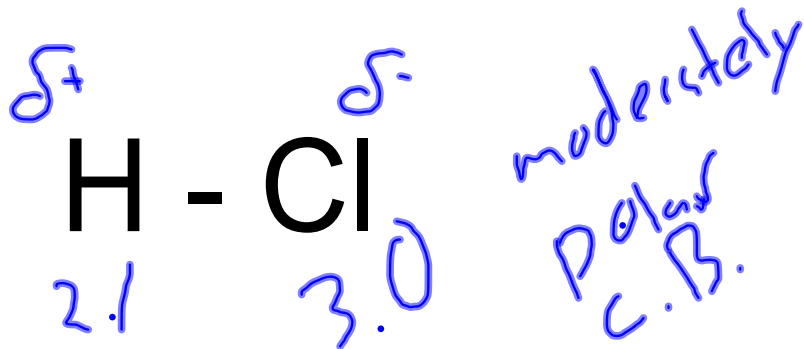

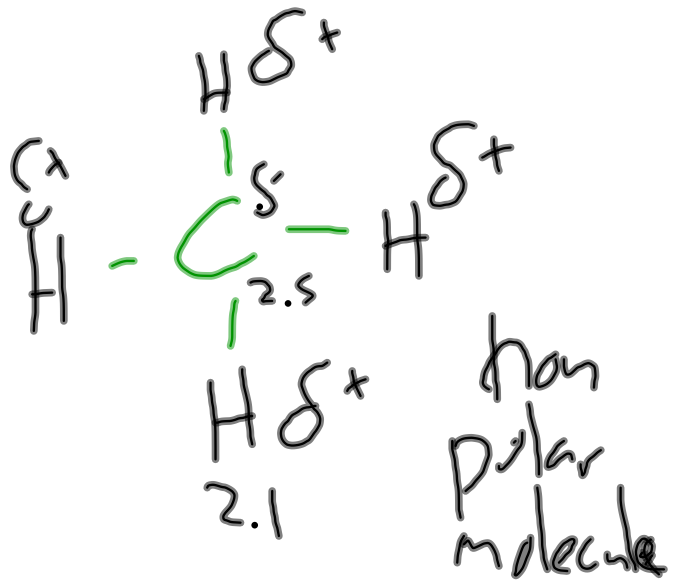
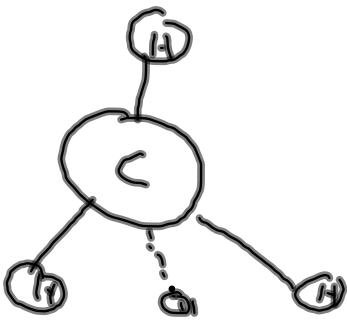
Polar Molecules

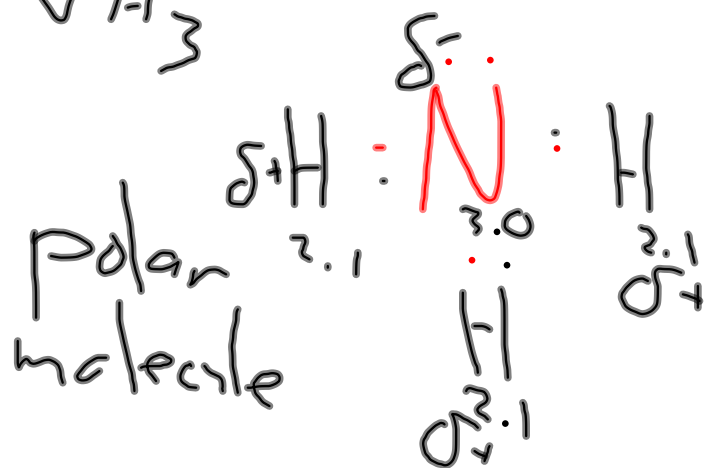
In a polar molecule, one end of the molecule is slightly negative, and the other end is slightly positive.



-Partial charges are often called charged regions or poles.

A molecule with two poles is called a **dipole**.
