



## <u>W</u>arm-Up


Everyday ~ dReveal-Recliiters of digested food, liquids and digestive juices flow through the digestive system.





The Job of the Liver

- The liver is the largest organ inside the body.
- The <u>liver</u> produces <u>bile</u>, which breaks down large pieces of fat into very small droplets.
- The small droplets can then be further broken down by enzymes from the pancreas.
- Bile is stored in the gallbladder, and then enters the small intestine.



## #5 Large Intestine

A <u>watery</u> mixture of <u>undigested</u> food moves from the small intestine to the large intestine.

the last part of the digestive system


called large because it is wider (7cm) than the <u>small</u> intestine (2.5cm)

<u>undigested</u> material enters here and has a lot of water and minerals in it (<u>absorbed</u> into the blood)

Contains <u>bacteria</u>, which use waste material to make vitamins B and K.

large intestine

- The <u>feces</u> are the remaining solid waste material.
- Feces are stored temporarily in the <u>rectum</u>, and then exit through the <u>anus</u>.
