LEADERSHIP CAMP 2014

Adventures in Miramichi will be offering a Leadership Adventure camp for youth ages 15 to 17.

The goal of this 6 day camp is to offer leadership skill development through numerous outdoor and adventure type activities. Campers will learn that challenge, enjoyment, creativity, self-expression and social interaction are important, life-enhancing experiences. These will be enriched and nurtured through activities such as: climbing and rappelling, (MVHS Challenge Course), knot tying, team building, canoeing, archery, geocaching, outdoor cooking, mountain biking and debriefing activities. The culminating activity of the camp is an overnight canoeing out trip on the Miramichi River.
